WHEREAS, the District desires to adopt certain rules, charges and penalties to implement said provisions;

BE IT RESOLVED that this resolution supersedes any other pervious resolution relating to the above-subject matter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Oakdale Irrigation District desires to implement the Irrigation Water Service and Related Fees Policy effective April 2, 2019.





BACKGROUND AND/OR HISTORY:

The owner of the parcel noted above wishes to receive irrigation water on the property. The parcel was disconnected from OID services in 2013, and is therefore subject to the Parcel Reconnection process per OID policy. Since the 3 acre parcel is less than 10 acres in size it is considered substandard and requires Board approval to reconnect. A condition of substandard parcel reconnections is that the parcel be connected to a private facility. The landowner has already secured permission from the neighboring property to utilize a private pipeline which is served by an existing turnout on the OID Lesnini Lateral No. 1. Valves have been installed and tested to ensure the parcel has an independent delivery point. As the landowner's request is not anticipated to negatively impact OID operations, staff recommends approval of the substandard Parcel Reconnection.



The following project condition shall apply to APNs: 229-060-10, 229-060-19, and 229-060-20, as described in the attached **Exhibit "A"** Legal Description of the Subject Properties and shown on the attached **Exhibit "B"** Project Site Map.

1. Prior to such time as either parcel is sold, or there is a change in ownership, or there is a change in the current agricultural land use of said parcels, the parcels shall be prepared to irrigate and drain independently. Private irrigation pipelines shall be installed from the historic point(s) of delivery, in a manner that will provide independent and measureable irrigation to the parcels. OWNERS shall be responsible for all costs incurred.

By signing below, OWNERS of the subject parcels, hereby agree to comply with the above-described condition of approval. Failure to comply with this Agreement shall result in DISTRICT withholding irrigation water until such time as the listed condition is met.

THIS AGREEMENT shall be a covenant binding upon both DISTRICT and OWNERS.



RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approve Development of Professional Services Agreement with Fedak & Brown, LLP for Audit Services in 2019, 2020 and 20121 with a Cost that is Inclusive of the Preparation of an Annual Financial Statement (AFS) and Bring Back to the Board for Approval

BACKGROUND AND/OR HISTORY:

Staff is requesting the development of a Professional Services Agreements (PSA) with Fedak & Brown, LLP to cover the audit years of 2019, 2020 and 2021.

Prior to securing a price quote for this work, staff is requesting input from the Board regarding continuing or not in the preparation of a Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) or preparing an Annual Financial Statement (AFS), similar to other irrigation districts in our region.

The additional information required in a CAFR is geared more toward Cities and Counties, as entities that rely upon a property tax levy for a significant portion of its revenues. The AFS would include all of the disclosures required by OID's outstanding bond issue, items required by the Water Code and any other items that Management and the Board believe would provide useful information to users.

In 2018, there were a total of 4,328 entities from within the country that received the CAFR program award for 2017 statements. The majority of these were Counties and Cities. The program has been extended beyond state and local governments. Other categories include school districts, pension and other post-employment benefit systems, and stand-alone business-type activities. OID falls into the last category of stand-alone business-type activities, which comprises 522 of the 4,328 done nationwide in 2017. Of those, only 141 are in the State of California and only 4 of those are Irrigation Districts (El Dorado Irrigation District, Merced Irrigation District, OID, and Vista Irrigation District).

The audit fees from the consultant will not significantly change with any change to the reporting format chosen but Staff time however, will be significantly reduced. It is this savings in Staff time that is the reason for Staff supporting the cessation of the CAFR and the preparation of the AFS.

Upon the Board's direction, the Professional Services Agreement will be brought back on the Consent Calendar in June for approval by the Board.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approve Adoption of Resolution Finding the 2019 Temporary Water Transfer Agreement Between OID, SSJID and SEWD Exempt Under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)

BACKGROUND AND/OR HISTORY:

Under the 2019 Temporary Water Transfer Agreement (Project), the Oakdale Irrigation District (OID) and South San Joaquin Irrigation District (SSJID) will provide up to 1,000 acre-feet of water to the Stockton East Water District (SEWD) for irrigation purposes during the 2019 irrigation season. The proposed water to be provided is surplus to the current needs of OID and SSJID water users as a result of OID and SSJID's ongoing conservation efforts and efficiency improvements. The water provided will be used for irrigation of existing crops located on certain agricultural lands outside the SEWD boundaries. The intended recipients of the water have existing physical connections to serve as points of delivery on the SEWD facilities, and would rely solely on groundwater for their irrigation supply in the absence of the Project. Due to the location of the existing diversion and conveyance facilities, the Project is located in Calaveras, Tuolumne, Stanislaus, and San Joaquin Counties.

This Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations, Division 6, Chapter 3, Section 15301, Class 1, Existing Facilities. The Project utilizes existing public facilities for the movement of water per the agreement. There will be negligible or no expansion of existing diversion and conveyance facilities as a result of the Project.

Staff recommends adoption of the attached resolution as drafted finding the above Project exempt from CEQA. Staff will be available to answer any questions that the Board may have.

WHEREAS, the Oakdale Irrigation District (OID) and the South San Joaquin Irrigation District (SSJID), collectively referred to as "Districts", are California irrigation districts operating under and by virtue of Division 11 of the California Water Code; and

WHEREAS, the existing diversion and conveyance facilities are located in Tuolumne, Calaveras, Stanislaus, and San Joaquin Counties; and,

WHEREAS, OID is the custodian of the documents or other material which constitute the record of proceedings upon which the Board's decision is based, and the District office is the location of this record; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this Board of Directors that:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
- 2. The proposed Project has been determined by the Board of Directors to be categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations, Division 6, Chapter 3, Section 15301. Class 1, Existing Facilities.
- 3. A Notice of Exemption is approved (and is on file with the District's records).
- 4. The District's Staff is authorized and directed to file a Notice of Exemption at the Clerk's Office (or other authorized place) of Tuolumne, Calaveras, Stanislaus, and San Joaquin Counties and in the manner prescribed by the CEQA.

Therefore in the absence of the proposed Project, the intended recipient landowners outside the SEWD boundaries would solely utilize groundwater resources. The Project will benefit the Districts and the Eastern San Joaquin Groundwater Subbasin by providing up to 1,000 acre-feet of surface irrigation water to use in lieu of groundwater.



BACKGROUND AND/OR HISTORY:

The Emergency Water Supply Agreement (Project) proposes that the Oakdale Irrigation District (OID) and South San Joaquin Irrigation District (SSJID) will provide up to 100 acre-feet of water per year, measured October 1 through September 30, to the Chicken Ranch Rancheria Me-Wuk Indians of California (Tribe) as required for emergency beneficial uses. The proposed beneficial uses include municipal purposes by the Tribe, fire suppression on Tribal and non-Tribal lands, and a secure water supply for the Columbia Air Attack Base located in Tuolumne County. The purchased water will be drawn from OID/SSJID's water at Lake Tulloch and/or New Melones Reservoir. The Tribe will be responsible for declaring an emergency, notifying OID/SSJID, accessing and conveying the desired amount of water during an emergency. The Tribe will also be responsible for recording the volume of water provided and will be invoiced by OID/SSJID for all emergency water used, up to 100 acre-feet per year. Due to the location of Lake Tulloch and New Melones, the Project is located in Calaveras and Tuolumne Counties.

This Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to the emergency statutory exemption of the California Public Resources Code Section 21080, subdivision (b) (4), specific actions necessary to prevent or mitigate an emergency. The Project is intended to prevent or mitigate the loss of, or damage to, life, health, property or public services during sudden and unexpected emergency situations.

Staff recommends adoption of the attached resolution as drafted finding the above Project exempt from CEQA. Staff will be available to answer any questions that the Board may have.


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

Tim,

Are you, the managers, or board members are interested in getting out on the river in early June to observe NFP electrofishing? Our last sampling dates of the year are June 3-6, and 10-11. We usually start upstream at Oakdale and work downstream (so earlier dates are in the upper section of river), but if water temps are increasing, we may start downstream near the confluence and work upstream to make sure we can sample all units (electrofishing water temperature limit of 18C/64F).

The number of people we can accommodate depends on river flow and the reach we are sampling on a particular day. If the river is up we could take a large jet boat and fit 4 people, but if it's down we would take a smaller boat and could probably handle 2-3 people at a time. But, we may be able to take two boats, or schedule multiple days, if there is interest. I anticipate we would start in morning and shadow the electrofishing rafts for an hour, and be off the river around lunch. This depends on the day and where we put the boat(s) in and take out.

If you can determine if there is interest, the number of people, and the dates they

are available, we would plan accordingly and be able to provide more specifics as sampling approaches.
